Masterclasses for professional, student- and amateur -oboists
Friday, November 11 to Sunday November 13, 2022



As a continuation of the legendary Oboe Weekends on the Herzberg, the Oboe Weekend will take place for the first time in Muri, in the inspiring rooms of the Muri Monastery.

Our renowned tutors are passionate about teaching amateurs of all ages, students and professional musicians. Fostering new friendships and talking shop will be a pleasure for all of us.

In addition to individual lessons, we will play chamber music together under the direction of Renato and Leonardo Bizzotto (bassoon).

Basic structure:

Mornings and afternoons are devoted to one-on-one instruction. Participants can take literature of their own choice. The rest of the time can be spent individually: chamber music, listening to other participants, visiting the exhibition, testing instruments, making and testing reeds.

The course ends with a small concert of the participants on Sunday at 17:00.

Chamber music

Common, relaxed music making in between. The rehearsed works can be presented at the participants' concert.

Target group

The Oboe Weekend is aimed at all oboists. Professional musicians and students will get their money's worth with our internationally renowned instructors. But amateurs and students are also welcome and will be taught by the same instructors.

Jean-Louis Capezzali

studied with Gaston Longatte at the Versailles Conservatory. For four years he assisted Maurice Bourgue at the Conservatoire National de Paris and was promoted to full professor. He has taught at the Conservatoire National de Lyon since 1998 and at the HEMU in Lausanne, whose oboe class he founded, since 2008.



Marita Kohler

studied with Simon Fuchs at the ZhdK and with Jean-Louis Capezzali at the Conservatoire National de Lyon. In addition to regular solo performances, Marita Kohler devotes herself enthusiastically to orchestral and chamber music. She is principal oboist of the Basel Sinfonietta, a symphony orchestra specializing in contemporary music.



Sophie Le Denmat

studied oboe with Hélène Devilleneuve and Jean-Louis Capezzali, both super soloists in the Orchestre Philharmonique de Radio France. She performs regularly as a chamber musician and participates, for example, in the Festival de Pablo Casals in Prades. Since 2005 she has been teaching at the Conservatoires de Puteaux, where she holds a state diploma as professor of art education. There she is also head of the wind department

is the initiator of the international oboe and bassoon competition "the muri competition". As an orchestral musician, chamber musician and soloist, he has performed throughout Europe. He is a member of the Bläsersolisten Aargau and has organized international master classes for oboists and bassoonists on the Herzberg, which are now being continued in Muri. He is the artistic director of the Series "Musik im Festsaal" from Murikultur.
